Maths

Identify the value of each digit in numbers given to 3 decimal places and multiply numbers by 10, 100 and 1,000 giving answers up to 3 decimal places.

Multiply one-digit numbers with up to 2 decimal places by whole numbers.

Use written division methods in cases where the answer has up to 2 decimal places. Solve problems, which require answers to be rounded to specified degrees of accuracy. Solve problems involving the calculation of percentages [for example, of measures and such as 15% of 360] and the use of percentages for comparison.

Recall and use equivalences between simple fractions, decimals and percentages including in different contexts.

Use simple formulae, generate and describe linear number sequences, express missing number problems algebraically, find pairs of numbers that satisfy an equation with two unknowns, enumerate possibilities of combinations of two variables



English

To read with increasing familiarity a wide range of books, including fiction from our literary heritage and books from other cultures and traditions. To complete comprehension tasks drawing inferences such as inferring characters' feelings, thoughts and motives from their actions, and justifying inferences with evidence. Using the novel, "In the footsteps of Crazy Horse", explore and write fictional biographies and autobiographies, narrative and explanations surrounding the Native American culture. Identify the meaning of new words through use of knowledge of root words, prefixes and suffixes. Revise homophones, antonyms and synonyms. Use dashes, hyphens, ellipses, semicolons and colons. Revise parts of grammar including active/passive voice and subject/object. Revise nouns, adjectives, verbs, adverbs, conjunctions and prepositions. Extend knowledge of spelling strategies and apply to high-frequency and cross-curricular words from the Years 5 and 6 word list.
