## Term 3 - Pole to Pole

#### Science: Seasonal Changes

Observe changes across the 4 seasons. Observe and describe weather associated with the seasons and how day length varies. Pupils should observe and talk about changes in the weather and the seasons. Pupils might work scientifically by making tables and charts about the weather; and making displays of what happens in the world around them, including day length, as the seasons change.

#### <u>RE</u>

GOSPEL: What is the good news Jesus brings? Tell stories from the Bible and recognise links with a concept of good news. Give clear simple accounts of stories such as Matthew the tax collector. Recognise that Jesus gives us instructions on how to behave.
