Hello from Butterfly Class! Firstly, I would like to let you know how wonderfully the children have been settling into their new class and school environment. We understand that things may be a little different than usual for them at the moment, but the children have

At current, home learning books are not to be returned to school between weeks and only to be returned at the end of each term.

At the end of the term, children are free to bring in their homework as part of our 'WOW Homework Day' on Thursday 22nd October and celebrate the wonderful work the children have produced at home.
