Dear Parents & Carers.

It is a pleasure to be able to welcome all the children back after being away for so long. I am so pleased with how the children have settled back into school life and it is as if they have never been away!

As part of our recovery curriculum, Squirrel class will be following the EYFS framework for the next two terms and will be taking part in daily well-being activities as part of their **Personal**, **Social and Emotional** development.

For term 1, our topic is 'Dinosaurs'. In Literacy and Communication & Language the children will be exploring key texts, such as 'Trouble at the Dinosaur Café', 'How to look after your Dinosaur' and 'Tyrannosaurus Drip'. We will be learning about the different types of dinosaurs, herbivores and carnivores, looking at their bones and their similarities and differences.

In Mathematics we will be investigating number bonds, measuring and problem solving with doubling, sharing and halving.

Due to the current pandemic it does mean that reading and home learning will need to be done slightly differently for now.

Reading books will go home on a **Tuesday** and will NEED to be returned on a **Friday** in order to be quarantined appropriately.
