Year 1 Squirrel Class

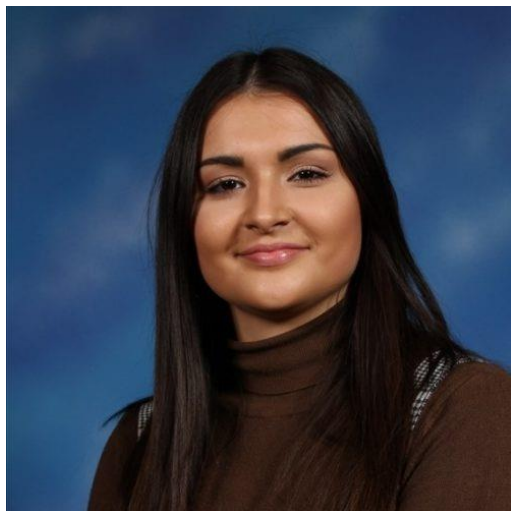

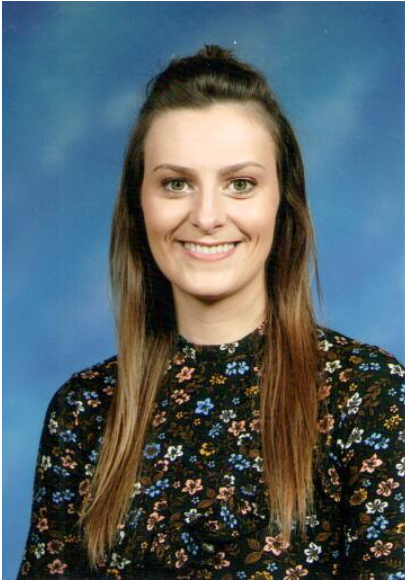
