Over the next 4 weeks we will be continuing with our Recovery Curriculum. This means we will be looking closely at gaps in the children's learning, particularly in phonics, reading, grammar, punctuation and spelling and maths. To ensure our curriculum remains broad, the rest of the subjects including science, music, humanities and art will be taught through our topic. Religious education and PE are taught separately.

<u>Topic</u>

Our topic for this term is THE CIRCUS. So far we have explored the life of a young circus entertainer and created some clown face masks. We have also started a non-chronological report on Tigers. Over the coming weeks, we will be debating if animals should be used in the Circus.

<u>PE</u>

We have just introduced an online reading programme called Collins E-books. Please have a go with these and shout if you have any difficulties.
