Firstly, I would like to say how lovely it has been having the children back in school again and being able to see them interact with their class friends again. Everyone has transitioned back to school very well and we are all super excited to start face to face teaching again.

Our topic for this term is 'Jurassic Park'. This means the children will be reading a variety of different fiction and non-fiction books such as 'If I had a dinosaur' by Alex Barrow & Gabby Dawnay, 'How to Grow a Dinosaur' by Caryl Hart and Ed Eaves, and 'Questions and Answers about Dinosaurs' by Katie Daynes. We will be focusing

on learning about the different types of dinosaurs, when and where they lived, and what it would be like to have our own pet dinosaur.

To support the children over the next four weeks, our focus in EYFS will be in the areas of communication and language, personal, social and emotional development, and physical development.
