Multiplication and Division

- Multiply and divide 2-digit numbers by 1-digit number
- Multiply and divide 3-digit numbers by 1-digit number

Measurement (Area)

- Understand that area is the amount space is taken up by a 2D shape or surface

- Explore the most efficient method of counting squares and draw shapes of a precise area

Plants
