<u>Covid</u>

Schools are asked to assist in the NHS Test and Trace process. This means that if your child has a positive PCR test result that occurs within 2 days of them being in school, you must inform me. Please do this via email – <u>headteacher@teynham.kent.sch.uk</u> This is so that all close contacts, in school cases the staff and parents of children in the positive case person's bubble, can be informed and then follow the correct isolation procedures.
