



The school would be rebuilt on the current school playing field with the number of classes and facilities required for a new 2FE primary school. The proposals will require a separate planning consultation process that will run alongside the education consultation.

### 3. How can I give my views on the proposals?



### 5. The consultation process – indicative timeline

Date	Information
03 November to 01 December 2022	Consultation period
10 November 2022	Consultation event at Teynham Primary School 3:00pm to 7:00pm
May 2023	Following the consultation, all views received, will be reported to the Cabinet Member for Education and Skills.
June/July 2023	If the Cabinet Member decides to proceed with the proposals, KCC will publish a public notice for a four-week period in a local newspaper, at the school and on the KCC and school website. During this time comments and objections can be made about the proposals.
July 2023	The Cabinet Member considers all responses made and decides whether to proceed with the proposals.
September 2025	Subject to consideration of any objections, the proposal is implemented.
